MINIMAL IMPACTS

• Wetlands and Other Surface Waters

- Mostly existing stormwater swales and canal banks within the existing right of way
- Potential impacts from off-site drainage ponds

• Wildlife & Habitat

- Snail Kite (Federal)
- Caracara (Federal)
- Scrub Jay (Federal)
- Wood Stork (Federal)
- Eastern Indigo Snake (Federal)
- West Indian Manatee (Federal)
- Red-Cockaded Woodpecker (Federal)

• Natural Resources

- Floodplains
- Water Quality

• Farmlands

- No impacts from mainline widening
- Potential impacts from off-site drainage ponds

• Traffic Noise

- Traffic Noise levels are not predicted to exceed FDOT's noise criteria
- No abatement treatments required

• Contamination

- 3 High Risk and 17 Medium Risk Sites

- No impacts from mainline widening
